FINGERS AND TOES COMPETITION 2025 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entry to all classes must be:

- The original work of the entrant
- To have been completed between 31st August, 2024 and 31st August, 2025
- Meet the guidelines for each class and suitable for general exhibition
- Entries must not have been previously exhibited at any show or exhibition

Exhibitors may enter as many times and in as many classes as they wish.

All entries forms must be returned by 4th August, 2025, late entries will not be accepted. **Do not send entries with the entry forms.**

Entry costs will be \$10.00 for as many entries as you wish, children \$5.00 for as many entries as you wish.

Payment must accompany the Entry Form (see Entry Form for payment details).

Exhibits can be delivered by hand to Kyneton Showgrounds on Monday 1st September (10.00 am to 12.00 pm) or posted to 65 Garth Road, Carlsruhe, Vic. 3442, at no cost to the Committee, to arrive by this date.

Late entries will be accepted if the post mark is prior to this date.

Entries will be judged on construction, wearability, finishing techniques, **special consideration will be given to unusual approach and creativity.**

Judges decisions are final.

Insurance of articles remains the responsibility of the entrant.

GLOVES, FINGERLESS GLOVES AND WRIST WARMERS ETC.

Class 1

Gloves hand knitted from handspun yarn, adult

Class 2

Gloves hand knitted from commercial yarn, adult 4 ply

Class 3

Wrist warmers hand knitted from handspun yarn, adult

Class 4

Wrist warmers crocheted from handspun yarn, adult

Class 5

Wrist warmers hand knitted from commercial yarn, adult, 8 ply

Class 6

Wrist warmers crocheted from commercial yarn, adult 8 ply

Classes 7-10: Fingerless gloves should have defined fingers/thumb to the first knuckle

Class 7

Fingerless gloves hand knitted from handspun yarn, adult

Class 8

Fingerless gloves hand knitted from commercial yarn, 8 ply

Class 9

Fingerless gloves hand knitted from commercial yarn, 4 ply

Class 10

Fingerless gloves from commercial yarn, any ply

Class 11

Wrist warmers hand knitted by Primary School aged child

Class 12

Wrist warmers knitted by child aged from 10-13 years, 8 ply

SOCKS, BOOTEES ETC.

Class 13

Pair of socks hand knitted from handspun yarn, adult

Class 14

Pair of socks hand knitted from commercial wool, adult 4 ply

Class 15

Pair of socks suitable for a child hand knitted from commercial yarn, 4 ply

Class 16

Baby's bootees (traditional), hand knitted from commercial yarn, 4 ply

Class 17

Baby's socks, 4 ply

Class 18

Slippers felted

Class 19

Slippers hand knitted from commercial yarn (any ply)

Class 20

Slippers crocheted from commercial yarn (any ply)

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Class 21

Knitted or crocheted Christmas Stocking (must be shaped like a sock)

Class 22

Smallest pair of socks

Class 23

Gloves and or socks with a Daffodil Theme

Class 24

Bed socks, hand knitted from commercial yarn (any ply)

Class 25

Bed socks, crocheted from commercial yarn (any ply)

Class 26

Leg warmers, hand knitted from commercial yarn, 10 ply

Class 27

Leg warmers, crocheted from commercial yarn, 10 ply

Class 28

Most decorative Finger Puppet (1), hand knitted from commercial yarn, any ply

Class 29

Most decorative set of Finger Puppets (5), hand knitted from commercial yarn, any ply

Class 30

Sock Puppet, must be sock shaped, hand knitted or crocheted from commercial yarn, any ply

Class 31

Sock Puppet, must be sock shaped, hand knitted or crocheted from hand spun yarn

All classes to have a sample of hand spun yarn, commercial yarn to have label attached.

Hand spun wool can be wool or a mixture of other fibres.

Hand spun to be 11-17 WPI

WPI is the number of yarn wraps to one (1) inch. Not to be pulled too tight or leaving too loose.
